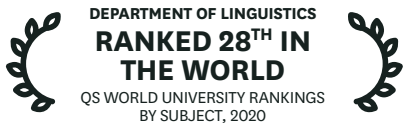
- Study your first year at Korea University and enjoy the benefits of teaching staff and resources from both Macquarie and Korea University.
